Federal Work-Study Program Volume in Inflation-Adjusted Dollars (in Millions)




Following a period of steady decline, in recent years funding for the Federal **Work-Study** Program has slightly increased.

Institutional Aid for Undergraduate and Graduate Students



In 2020-21, institutions provided an estimated \$57 billion in grant aid to undergraduate students — 33% of total undergraduate aid, and 48% of undergraduate grant aid.

Institutional grants accounted for 68% of all graduate student grant aid in 2020-21, whereas federal grants, including aid to veterans, accounted for 8% in 2020-21.


