
More Than Just Books by Golemon Library Assistant, Helen Cozart

What do you know about AI and programs like ChatGPT? There is a lot of controversy, and we have a couple of examples of the disaster that can come from generalized use, but if you are interested in figuring out productive solutions, we have set up a website with a ton of information. It is actually not all bad. ChatGPT can make a pretty good outline that gives students direction for their research. There are even some, like Semantic Scholar, that index academic papers so the information isn't entirely made up. Like everything else related to information literacy, it can be a challenge to figure out what is good stuff. The library can help you find useful ways to teach students about AI and ways to use it.

What to do this weekend: Chisholm Trail – 150 Years of History, Folklore, and Legacy opens August 31 at the Eastland County Museum. It runs through October 27th, but since they are only open Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 10 – 2, you really can't skip it.
